v1

"Malta" means 'refuge.'

v2

"The native people" Gk barbaroi; 'barbarian; foreigner'

The capacity for, and ability to convey kindness and mercy lies innate in all human beings.

"unusual kindness"

Remnants of the image of God that remains in mankind

Even unbelieving pagans have the God-given capacity to extend kindness and do good things.

Romans 2:14-15

Christians, above all, are called to possess a heart of kindness that produces goodness.

Kindness is the internal desire for the peace, happiness, and well-being of others.

Goodness is the external action that helps bring that about.

They are listed together as "fruit of the Spirit" in Galatians 5:22.

True justice is the right application of God's law.
