**B. Empowering Us for W\_\_\_\_\_**

**2. Disciples (by extension the Church) Would Be Witnesses—Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the Uttermost Parts of the Earth!**

**3. The Witness Would Be by the Power of the Holy Spirit!**

**4. Today, Believers Have a Charge, an Obligation to Witness!**

**→ Example: Peter, John and the Early Church**

**2. Peter Boldly Asserted an Elevated Principle of Civil Disobedience—4:19 & 5:29**

**3. The Early Church Raised Their Voices to Heaven—4:24, 29**

**4. The Church Was Visited by the Spirit of God—4:31**

**5. The Apostles Witnessed with Great Power!—4:33**

**6. Great grace was upon the Church—4:33b**

- 1 Peter 5:6-7

**1. Believers are to humble ourselves under God's mighty Hand—5:6**

**2. God, in His time, will exalt us—5:6b**

**3. We, Saints, are to throw our concerns on Him. He cares for us!—5:7**

**4. God's MIGHTY hand is present in all of this!—5:6a**

- Romans 15:13
