Sermon: Hebrews 2:1-3a

- 1. Read Hebrews 2:2. God is just, meaning that every transgression against God's commands must be punished by God. What does this mean for humanity in light of scriptures like Romans 3:10-12 and Ephesians 2:1-3?
- 2. Since all are guilty before God, how can anyone be justified in the eyes of God? See Romans 3:21-26.
- 3. According to 2 Corinthians 5:21, Isaiah 53:6,10-12, and Titus 2:14 how was the sin of believers dealt with justly by God?
- 4. Is it important for a person to understand that they have sinned against God in order to understand salvation? Explain.
- 5. Even Moses suffered the consequences for not obeying God. What was his transgression and what was his punishment? See Numbers 20:10-12 and Deuteronomy 32:51-52.
- 6. Some people think that Moses' sin also caused him to not be allowed into heaven as he was not allowed into the Promised Land. What do you think? See Luke 9:28-30.
- 7. Why were the people that escaped from Egypt not allowed to enter into the Promised Land? Scan through, or read Numbers 13 and 14.
- 8. Who were the only two adults among the Exodus generation that were allowed to enter into the Promised land? See Numbers 26:63-65. ______ and _____. What happened to the other ten spies that did not trust God and lied to the people? See Numbers 14:36-38.
- 9. When angels mediated the law to Israel, they delivered a message that if obeyed brought the blessings of God, but if disobeyed, the curse of God. Israelites. What does this mean for us now that God Himself, Jesus Christ, has personally delivered to us the message of salvation?
