CHAPTER 3.

Part III. Christ, object of the believer's faith, desire, and expectation (Phil. 3. 1-21).

(1) Warning against Judaizers

FINALLY, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you, to me indeed is not grievous, but for you it is safe. Beware of "dogs," beware of "evil workers," beware of the "circumcision." For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the "spirit," and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the "flesh."

1 Thes 5:16 rejoice evermore  
2 Pet 1:12, 15 put always in remembrance

(2) Warning against trusting in legal righteousness.

4 Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more
