## ■ A Tone-Setting Eulogy

- o Merciful rebirth; unequal participation
- o A living hope because of a Savior who lives
  - Our hope is anchored in the past—He is risen. Our hope is steadfast in the present—He is living. Our hope is completed in the future—He is coming.
  - We hope, we don't "wish."
    - No resurrection = no living hope = no biblical Gospel
