- B. The "Bad News" is that NO ONE is righteous before God
- C. BUT, the Gospel is the Revelation of the Righteousness of God
- D. Romans 3:21-26 Shows us God's Righteousness in the Death of Jesus

II. The Righteousness of God Revealed in the Gospel (Romans 3:21-26)

- A. The Righteousness of God Manifested Apart from the Law Romans 3:21
 - I. "Has been Manifested"
 - "Bears Witness"
- B. The Righteousness of God Through Faith in Jesus Christ Romans 3:22
 - 1. "Through faith in Jesus Christ" (διὰ πίστεως Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ)
 - a) "Faith IN Christ"
 - b) "Faith(fulness) **OF** Christ"
 - 2. "Through faith in Christ" contrasted with "by works of the law"
- C. There is NO DISTINCTION
 - I. All are Guilty Romans 3:23
 - 2. All are Justified by Grace Romans 3:24
- D. Jesus Christ: Our Substitute & Our Satisfaction Romans 3:25
 - 1. "Are Justified" = "To Justify, to declare righteous"
 - 2. Debate between Protestants & Roman Catholics
 - 3. Double Imputation
 - 4. "Propitiation" = "To turn away, to appease"
- E. The Righteousness of God Demonstrated Romans 3:26
 - I. Divine Forbearance
 - 2. "Just and the Justifier"
