Jeremiah 5 **A Few Good Men** (Not!)

Sunday School 9/12/2021

I. The Prophet's assignment

v 1 - 5

Jeremiah is commanded to search the nation for a faithful man (v 1).

- v 1 the End-times are evil-times Ezekiel 22:30, Micah 7:2
- v 2 religious hypocrites Psalm 78:35-37, Titus 1:16
- v 3 the Lord's vision, eyes 1 Kings 9:3
- v 4 spiritual ignorance Jer 8:7, Matthew 16:2-4
- v 5 the great men two types in the Bible : 1. Earthly Josh 14:15 (Arba) 2 K 5:1 (Naaman) 2. Heavenly **Isaiah 66:2**, Jeremiah 6:16

II. The Lord's Assessment

v 6 - 25

Since no faithful man is left, the Lord assesses the lack of fruit, and threatens Judah with the 'Day of Visitation' (v 9).

- v 6 Sin's penalty is predatory ~ lion, wolf, leopard
- v 7 A Lost Generation thy children have forsaken me Psalm 78:1-6
- v 9 The Day of Visitation is coming hx: chapter 39 doct: The Tribulation
- v 10 *take away her battlements* hx: Judah's walled cities, spir: perversions (false bibles) Why? *for they are not the Lord's*!!
- v 11-12 They did not believe God's prophet when he spake God's words of imminent judgment.
- v 13 Judah's false prophets (v 31) despise God's true word
- v 14 this word = false prophecy, spir: Today's modern bible teachers are stink at prophecy
- v 15-17 hist: Babylonian invasion spir: the Hebrew/Greek scholar invasion of evangelicals
- v 20-23 God *declares* that *foolish people without understanding publish* false bibles. And those who read them acquire *a rebellious heart*.

III. The Leader's Arrogance

v 26 - 31

The Lord describes the *wicked men* who *set snares* and *traps of deceit and wax rich*. spir: Hebrew/Greek scholars and the money (\$\$) they make from *publish*ing (v20).

IV. The Lord's Assurance

v 10 & 18

I will <u>not</u> make <u>a full end</u> of thee 1 Thes 2:16, Romans 11:1 & 5-6, Exo 33:12-13

Truth / Irony: the words - *judge*, *judgment* and *truth* are found 7x in this chapter. *love* is only found once in verse 31.
