I. THE DEFINITION OF CHRISTIAN MATURITY

- A. What is Christian maturity?
 - 1. Christlike maturity is love like Paul displayed (vs. 8)
 - 2. Christlike maturity is not sentimental love (vs. 9)
 - 3. Christlike maturity is revealed in wisdom and uprightness (vs. 10)
 - 4. Christlike maturity is a life to the glory and praise of God (vs. 11)

II. THE BASIS OF CHRISTIAN MATURITY

- A. The basis (root) of Christian maturity is love
 - 1. A Christian is man in whom the love of God is shed abroad (Rom. 5:5)
 - 2. To be a growing to glory as a Christian, our love needs to abound! a. original idea is a 'fountain flowing'
 - b. examples besides Jesus: Timothy (2:20-21) Epaphroditus (2:25-30)
 - 3. How to abound in this Christian love?
- B. Christian Maturity is not just lots of love (9b)
 - 1. It is love balanced with knowledge and judgment (discernment)
 - 2. It is love like Paul displayed in his ministry of prayer and preaching

3. It is love that isn't wasted by poor manners or wrong objects

III. THE FRUIT OF CHRISTIAN MATURITY

- A. We all face choices dilemma's crossroads crisis
 - 1. Some choices straightforward: God's clear commands
 - 2. Some choices take much discretion: no clear command
- B. Christian maturity blooms in attractive fruits
 - 1. Mature mindset: approve things that are excellent
 - a. immaturity is when we make choices based on feelings
 - b. mature mindset focusses on the essential and eternal (Col. 1:9-11)
 - highly necessary as we face cultural crisis years
 - 2. Upright walk: to be sincere and without offence till day of Christ a. sincere is when we walk according to light of truth in fear of God
 - b. without offence is when we don't cause others to stumble
 - c. day of Christ: what will Jesus be looking for when He comes?
 - 3. Inner glory: final harvest of all God's work is vs. 11

LIVING THE TRUTH

A. There is but one way to live these truths: through Jesus Christ (11b)
