 - The First Thing We See From These Verses Is:
 - A Proposal From Christ!
 - He Says "Whoso Eateth My Flesh, And Drinketh My Blood!"
 - The Benefits Of Spiritual Communion With Christ:
 - Is Open To Anyone:
 - Who Eats His Flesh:
 - By Turning To Him!
 - And Who Drinks His Blood:

- By Trusting In Him!
- Now There Are A Couple Of Interesting Shifts:
 - In This Verse 6:53!
 - First The Underlying Word John Used For "Eating" Is An Entirely Different Word:
 - Than He Used Already Through This Chapter!
 - The Word Can Also Be Translated "Chew!"
 - It's A More Graphic Word:
 - Than Just "To Eat!"
 - Perhaps Jesus Wanted To Show Us That Its Not Just About:
 - A One-Time Bite, But A Savoring Of Him That Leads To The Fullest Life He Has To Give! **IE:** Aunt
 - The Other Shift Is That:
 - "Eat" In 6:53 Is Put As A One-Time Act!
 - But Here In 6:54 It Is In The Present Tense As An Ongoing Activity!
- So This Is Jesus' Proposal To You & To Me!
 - Come To & Believe In Him:
 - Not Just One Time But:
 - All The Time!
 - Because This Is What Will Nourish You:
 - Through All Eternity!
 - 6:54 "Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life!"
 - But Then Again John Records:
- A Promise From Christ!
 - 6:54b "And I will raise him up at the last day!"
 - This Is The 4th Time Jesus Says This:
 - In This Chapter!
 - In 6:39 Jesus Describes The Certainty:
 - Of His Promise!
 - "And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day!"
 - In 6:40 Jesus Describes The Completion:
 - Of His Promise!
 - "And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day!"
 - In 6:44 Jesus Describes The Coordination:
 - Of His Promise With His Father!
 - "No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day!"
 - And Then Here 6:54 Jesus Describes His Commitment:
 - To His Promise!
 - If You Just Take Him At His Word!
 - "Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day!"
 - What An Encouragement:
 - To Keep Eating & Drinking:
 - What Christ Has To Give!
 - To Keep Turning To & Trusting In Him!
 - And Its All Because Of:
- The Properties Of Christ:
 - And His Flesh & Blood!
 - In 6:55 "For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed!"
 - Here Jesus Says That:
 - His Real Human Flesh:
 - Is A Real Kind Of Food! And:
 - His Real Human Blood:
 - Is A Real Kind Of Drink!
 - His Actual Body & Blood:
 - Is What Makes Spiritual, Eternal, Resurrection Life:
 - Even Possible!

- If Jesus Did Not Have: - A Real Body - Or - Real Blood: - None Of This Could Be True: - For You! - So - The "Flesh & Blood" Of Jesus: - Is Real Spiritual Food: - For Real Spiritual Life! - But - You Can Only Partake Of It In A Spiritual Way! - By Faith! - But -When You Do: - You Will Find That The: - Body & Blood Of Jesus: - Is Energizing: - To Your Soul! - Because - Not Only Must You: - Eat Him To Live! - You Must Eat Him: - To Live & Labor: - For Him! - IE: Food Is What Strengthens & Sustains Your Body For Living! Christ Is What Strengthens & Sustains Your Soul For Service! - So - Keep "Eating His Flesh" & "Drinking His Blood!" - To "Eat His Flesh" Means: - To Keep Going To Him: - When You Need To Be Revived: - To Live For Christ! - To "Drink His Blood" Means: - To Keep Believing In Him: - When You Need to Be Refreshed: - In Your Labors For Christ! - So - When It Comes To Jesus: - Don't Just Eat To Live! - Live To Eat! * Because - Then - If You Keep: - You Will Be Able To Experience And Enjoy: A Great Connection! - A Great Connection: - With The Lord! - Even As He Tells Us In: - 6:56-67 - "He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. / As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me!" - IE: Another Familiar Expression - When It Comes To Food Is - "You Are What You Eat!" - And - What Is True Physically Is Also True Spiritually! - As Jesus Describes In These Verses: - The Effects Of: - "Eating His Flesh & Drinking His Blood!" - The Main Effect Is: - A Special Communion With Christ! - Because - When You: - Eat Jesus' Flesh: - By Coming To Him!
