3. *What important connection is there between the LORD's two-fold declaration that He is the I AM THAT I AM ("the LORD, the LORD...), and the description of His attributes that follows?*
4. *How does our text confirm that the LORD does what He does (v. 7) because He is who He is (v. 6)?*
5. *What important aspect of His character does God reveal by the statement that He "will by no means clear the guilty"? What connection is there between this statement and the cross of Calvary?*
6. *What important connection is there between Exodus 34:6-7 and both John 1:18 & John 14:9?*
