- Why is that so challenging for us to do?
- How is self-emptying actually an addition rather than a subtraction?
- What was the result of Jesus' mindset and actions?

### Digging Deeper: (Suggested Time 20 minutes)

Read Mark 10:35-45 and discuss the following questions.

• What was the fundamental problem with James & John's request?



- Why do you think the other disciples were indignant or very displeased with their request?
- How did Jesus respond to ensuing disunity that arose among the disciples?
- Why is Jesus' statement in verse 45 so powerful?
- How does having the heart, attitude and actions of a servant bring unity?

# Application: (Suggested Time 10 minutes)

- Remember that we are created out of servant love for servant love.
- What areas of control do you need to surrender? How have you been prideful in your relationships with others? Surrender those to God and ask for His forgiveness.
- How can you serve others in your relationships this week? Ask God to inconvenience you so you can serve someone else in a practical way.
