Sermon Outline

Greater than Moses

Before going into his warning exhortations, the author adds one more affirmation to increase confidence that Jesus is "greater than." Hebrews 3:1-6

Introduction: Apostasy is real The greatness of Moses in Judaism

Exposition: Jesus is greater

Context: The vital importance of context of the warning passages Jesus's high priesthood (2:17-18, 4:14-16)

- v. 1: Holy brothers, consider Jesus
- v. 2-4: Moses was faithful, but ... Jesus is infinitely greater The reflected glory of Moses (Exodus 34) The greater glory of Jesus (Luke 9)
- v. 5-6a: The Son who reigns over the house is greater than the member of the house Numbers 12:4-11
- v. 6b A present indicative (we are) based on a future conditional imperative (if we hold fast)

Application: Guard against personal apostasy

Count church members as "holy brethren." (2 Tim 2:19) Exhort one another every day (3:12-14) Examine yourself, hold on and press on Consider Jesus

- 1. Our confidence (in prayer)
- 2. the boast of our hope
