- 3. We must be taught what genuine righteousness looks like, (vs. 7: 1 29)
 - C. Genuine righteousness travels through the narrow way of God's instruction, (vs. 12 14)
 - 1) Righteousness is not philosophical, it is very practical, (vs. 12); "For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous before God, but the doers of the law who will be justified." (Romans 2:13 ESV)
 - 2) As a believer I MUST enter the narrow way, (vs. 13a); "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him," (Colossians 2:6 ESV)

3) There are many who have not found the path to life, (vs. 13b - 14); "There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death. ""Even in laughter the heart may ache, and the end of joy may be grief." (Proverbs 14:12-13 ESV)
