Section Five C – Prov. 6:1-35 General Admonitions

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By its nature, it's can't be instantaneous

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What follows is some general principles about wisdom

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It shifts obligation from another to you
It creates a snare, trap & bondage for you
Extricate yourself from the situation if possible

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The ant is industrious in the season allotted
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Redeem the time – Do all you can while you can

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See the range of evil, engulfing the whole man

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See a fortiori argument—The hungry steal bread & must pay justice, so how much more so in this case

This brings utter destruction, for cannot buy your way out – the penalty is death!
