Praxis

1. If it is the True Shepherd who “seeks / summons” His own, why do Christians naturally perceive that “I sought / seek Jesus?” Should Christian witnessing & discipleship include telling people to “seek Jesus?”
2. What has Jesus led you out of? What is He presently seeking to lead you out of? [be specific here & then praise and pray about these details]
3. How does “He goes before them” apply to the task of Christian parents? Christian disciplers?
4. If the True Shepherd secures and satisfies his sheep both in heaven and on earth, how are Christians to experience security and satisfaction here on this troubled earth? How is that experience expressed in a life?”
