 - b. *leqach* something received, instruction (whether the teacher or hearer); also (in an active and sinister sense) inveiglement:--doctrine, learning, fair speech.

 - a. nurtured by parents in the things of the Lord vs 3; Eph 6:4
 - i. When I was my father's son, 1Ch 29:1
 - ii. Tender and the only one in the sight of my mother,
 - b. Dads appeal to me vs 4
 - i. "Let your heart retain my words; 1Ch 28:9
 - ii. Keep my commands, and live. Pr 7:2

 - 1. Get it Get wisdom! Get understanding!
 - a. Do not forget, *shakach* to mislay, to be oblivious of, from want of memory or attention, (cause to) forget.
 - b. nor turn away from the words of my mouth. *natah* to stretch or spread out; to bend away; decline, extend, go down, be gone, cause to yield.

 - a. Do not forsake her, and she will preserve you; 2Th 2:10
 - b. Love her, and she will keep you.
 - 3. Good Wisdom is the **principal** thing; of first priority Lu 10:42
 - a. Therefore get wisdom
 - b. And in all your getting, get understanding.
 - 4. And More
 - a. Exalt her,
 - b. Benefits she will
 - i. promote you;
 - ii. bring you honor, when you embrace her. 1Sa 2:30
 - iii. place on your head an ornament of grace; she will Pr 1:9; 3:22
 - iv. deliver to you a crown of glory
 - 5. One more time for Good Measure 10-13
 - a. Hear, and receive my sayings, And the years of your life will be many. 3:2
 - i. I have taught you in the way of wisdom;

 - i. your steps will not be hindered, Ps 18:36
 - ii. you will not stumble. Pr 3:23
