Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others:

1. What stood out to you in this sermon? Why?
2. What problems did Israel have when God spoke to them through the prophet Jeremiah?
3. What are some things in which you have boasted?
4. Why is it more valuable to know God than to have wisdom, might, and riches?
5. How does a person come to know God?
6. Do you know God? Explain.

Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking, or grow your understanding?
2. How do you at times boast in your wisdom, might, riches, etc.? What does this reveal about your heart?
3. What does it mean to know God? How is this different from knowing about God?
4. Is a person to grow in knowing God, or is knowing God something static (unchanging)? Explain.
5. A wrong application of this passage would be to try to escape from the world. Why might we want to escape from the world after studying this passage? Why would this be a wrong application?
6. How much do you value knowing God? Explain.
7. What should you do to seek a deeper knowledge of God?
8. What is the primary way you should be affected by this passage this week?
