Tell-Tale Signs of the Flesh

A. General Observations: Paul's list is...

- 1. Not CONCLUSIVE—5:21
- 2. CONTEXTUAL—tailor made for the Galatians. 5:15
- 3. COMMON—"the works of the flesh are evident"
- CATEGORICAL—seem to fall into certain divisions 4.

B. Specifics: The Four Categories. The works of the flesh involving....

- Sexual Sins -- Galatians 5:19
 - Adultery a.
 - Fornication b.
 - Uncleanness c.
 - Lewdness d.
- Religious Sins—Galatians 5:20 2.
 - Idolatry a.
 - b. Sorcery
- 3. Human Relations—Galatians 5:20-21a
 - Hatred a.
 - b. Contentions
 - c. Jealousies
 - Outbursts of anger d.
 - Selfish ambition e.
 - Dissensions and heresies f.
 - Envy g.
 - Murder h.
- Typically Pagan—Galatians 5:21a 4.
 - Drunkenness a.
 - Revelries b.

WARNING: "Those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God" С.

- Key word: *Practice*—habitual, continual action, not an occasional yielding to the flesh 1.
- 2. The assessment of a person's character in Scripture is always based on his common, habitual actions rather than on his occasional ones. Illustration: David
