# **QUESTIONS & COMMENTS:**

We are now beginning our look at the subject of evil in the world and its connection with Satan. We will begin by considering just what or who Satan is. The Christian needs to know the best way to overcome evil, recognize and resist temptation, and counter the plans of evil that seem to run rampant throughout the land. This, and future lessons, will be of help in the Christians fight to live above defeat.

### SATAN-HIS EXISTENCE

Is the Devil a living reality, or is he nothing more than a figment of the imagination? Is the word "Satan" merely a synonym for wickedness, or does it stand for a real being? In intellectual circles it has long been the custom to flatly deny the actual existence of a personal Satan. By many, Satan is now looked upon as a product of witchcraft, a relic of superstition, the myth of a bygone age. With others, Satan is nothing more than a principle of evil, a word used to identify all that is bad. Even those who still believe in a real Devil have a somewhat weird conception of his appearance. He is always portrayed as a monster in human form, having horns, hoofs and forked tail, dressed in red and carrying a pitchfork. Such a conception is an insult to intelligent people, and in consequence, the Devil has come to be regarded either as a "bogey man" with which to frighten naughty children, or as a fit subject for jest and joke.

The present disbelief in a real Devil is largely due to ignorance-ignorance concerning the teachings of God's Word, ignorance concerning the real Satan set forth in the Scriptures. It must be said, from the start, that the existence of Satan is taken for granted in the Bible from the opening of man's history. The Bible nowhere attempts to argue the existence of God. It assumes His being and asks the reader to exercise his faith and believe. In like manner, the Devil is mentioned. He appears in the Garden to tempt man without any explanation of where he came from. We are expected to take for granted the existence of God. Likewise, we are asked to do the same regarding Satan. The Bible offers as much proof for one as it does the other. Man's reason will always be a hindrance to believing and understanding spiritual truths.

In the Old Testament Satan is referred to in many Books, under different names. In the New Testament he is referred to by all the writers and mentioned in all 19 Books. There can be no denying that the Bible teaches the existence of a Devil. It has been stated that the Devil is mentioned by one name or another at least 174 times. What Jesus alone had to say should be sufficient proof that a real Devil exists. The Bible further points out that the Devil is not just evil in itself or merely some type of evil influence, but that the Devil is a person in every respect.
We will now attempt to study a few of the many Scriptures which prove that Satan is a real person and not just some abnormal influence in nature. Scriptures reveal Satan as having a high degree of intelligence.

(A descriptive title showing he is the one behind all false religions)
John 8:44
(A descriptive title which reveals his intent as well as how he opposes the truth and desires t mislead, deceive and confuse)
Revelation 12:9 (besides Satan & Devil)
(A descriptive title that reveals his nature and character)
1 Thessalonians 3:5
(A descriptive title which shows how he works to bring about his ends)
