Context:

- 1. Weep wealthy who have withdrawn help from the poor for Christ is coming soon (vv. 1-6).
- 2. Be patient brothers for Christ is coming soon (vv. 7-8).
- 3. Do complain about your complex Christian family because Christ is coming soon (v. 9).
- 4. Receive Encouragement from the prophetic prototype of endurance (vv. 10-11).
- 5. Don't swear. Say what you will do because judgment is pending.
