Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- Picture the events of verse 12; describe the humiliation and irony of that scene
- Why are there two high priests (Annas and Caiaphas); and what is up with going to Annas and then Caiaphas?
- Can you think of any reason John described Caiaphas as he did in verse 14?
- What contribution to the story do verse 15-18 make; i.e., why might John have included that detail?
- Read the parallel accounts to John 18:19-24 as noted above to get the rest of the story. What else transpired that John omitted from his account. What focus then does John draw?
- Besides feeling bad for Peter, what is significant about his predicted 3 fold denial?
- **Community Group Discussion:** Especially juxtaposed to Peter's 3 fold denial, what would you say John was trying to bring forward in his readers minds by recounting the events as he did in this passage?
