First: Divine Election and Reprobation Rejection of the Errors

Second: Christ’s Death and Human Redemption through It Rejection of the Errors

Third and Fourth: Corruption, Conversion, and the Way It Occurs Rejection of the Errors

Fifth: The Perseverance of the Saints Rejection of the Errors

Conclusion: Rejection of False Accusations
