

Catalyst Group Discussion Questions - Hosea 1:1-2:1

Week of September 18, 2011

Hosea chapter one introduces us to a family that God puts together to display how He has been scorned and rejected by the nation of Israel. His purpose is to show Israel how they have treated Him and how He plans to redeem them from their spiritual adultery.

Discussion

- Have you ever had to confront someone about a wrong they did to you? How did you feel while confronting them? What was the results of your confrontation with them?

Examination

- Why does God tell Hosea to marry someone who will prove to be unfaithful to him?
- What do the children of Hosea's dysfunctional marriage signify?
- How would you define spiritual adultery?
- Why does God tell Israel he will not be merciful to them any longer?
- How does God respond in grace to Israel? Why is this good news?

Application

- How do you believe this series on Hosea will challenge you in your life?
- In what ways have you seen the results of spiritual adultery impact your life?
- How will you respond to God upon being confronted with spiritual adultery?
- How does God's response of grace to you change and impact your life?
