 - a. The example of Jesus he quoted the Word of God. (Matt 4:1-11)
 - b. Could you use the book of Deuteronomy to fend off a temptation?
 - c. Imagine you are a licensed gun owner with a concealed carry permit during a crime.
 - d. You must fight falsehood with truth. Do you know the truth of the Word?
 - e. When tempted, fire gospel bullets at the temptation.
- 4. Used for Offense
 - a. Taking the word into the darkness, against the forces of evil.
 - b. It is storming the gates of hell, which will not be able to stand against the church.
- 5. Speaking the gospel to the world.
 - a. Current state of the Culture War
 - b. We need Bible believing evangelicals in every sphere of life being salt and light there.
- 6. If you put a sword in my hands, I will look silly.
 - a. Learn how to handle the word of God, learn how to interpret and apply it.
 - b. Coming of age in an Indian tribe.
