Bottom Line:

Our faith in Christ is a rational faith based on historical, scientific and biblical realities that should strengthen our convictions and increase our ability to boldly share our faith with those who might be skeptical and unbelieving.

- 1. "Hold your head up high intellectually as a follower of Christ. 2 Corinthians 10:5-6; Acts 17:22-31
- 2. Be encouraged and strengthened knowing that the evidence for our faith is <u>powerful</u> and <u>plentiful</u>. 2 Corinthians 10:5-6 -Clearly and lovingly share <u>evidence</u> (arguments) for the existence of God:
 - 1)The existence of matter and life point to God? (The cosmological argument):

The universe could not exist on its own so there must have been a first cause(uncaused cause) that brought it into being.

Note: Spontaneous generation (Abiogenesis) has NEVER been observed or induced (& has been virtually rejected by all scientists).

- 2) The amazing <u>complexity</u> (and design) found in nature points to God? (The teleological argument)
 Complexity & design leads on to the conclusion that a great "Intelligent Designer" (God) exists.
- 3) The existence and nature of DNA points to the existence of God?
 - DNA contains awesome amounts of information. Complex information demands an intelligent source.
- 4) The lack of <u>transitional fossils</u> in the fossil record points to a creator God. "The fossil record with its abrupt transitions offers no support for gradual change..." (Dr. Stephen Jay Gould, Harvard Professor of Paleontology)

All main kinds of living creatures were in the very early Cambrian Period (referred to as "Cambrian Explosion of Life"):

- 1) Animals with backbones (example...fish)
- 2) Animals without backbones (examples....shellfish, starfish).

"The 'Cambrian explosion' destroys the idea that all living things evolved from simple ancestors."

to the existence of an amazingly ingenious God. The demand that, for example, 40 complex parts could all appear simultaneously (which would be necessary for human sight) is an impossible task for evolution. These parts cannot develop slowly over time or there is no advantage for these non-functioning parts being present and, according to evolution, would not be passed on to the next generation because they offer no advantage.
