Hebrews 3.15-19 Part of a Mixed Multitude

The testimony of Scripture concerning the Exodus of Israel is that God brought out a mixed multitude. This means that among the millions that came forth, there were those who belonged to God in a particular manner, and those who did not. (although everything belongs to God by right of creation and just the fact of His being God) this mixed multitude was the pattern of the exodus, remained the pattern of the nation of Israel, and is even the pattern of the church of God today. There is STILL a mixed multitude! Part of the purpose of this life with all its challenges, pains, toil, and suffering as well as its hope, joy, promise and triumph is revelation OF that mixed multitude, as well as the purification of those who belong to God. The refining of the gold from the dross, the separation of the holy from the unholy... This reality of the mixed multitude is something that we need to understand because it is something that we live out every day!
