- A. The Prologue to Revelation **Revelation 1:1-3**
 - 1. "Things which must soon take place" (Revelation 1:1)
 - a) Daniel 2:28 (NKJV): But there is a God in heaven who reveals secrets, and He has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what will be in the latter days.
 - b) 2 Peter 3:8-9 (NKJV): But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. 9 The Lord is

not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
