SUPERIOR TO ANGELS

Hebrews 1:4-14 and 2:5-9

- I. <u>Angels</u>—supernatural created beings, from God to help God's people
 - **A.** There is a <u>Supernatural Realm of Reality</u>.—more going on than is visible.
 - B. Angels are <u>Created Spiritual Beings</u> who serve God. (1:7, 14)
 - **1. Messengers** (1:7; 2:2)—Angel means messenger or envoy, someone who delivers a message or conducts business on behalf of someone else.
 - 2. Ministers (1:14; Ps 91:11)—Minister means servant
 - **3. Outrank Humans** (2:6-8; Ps 8:4-6)—glory and power
 - a. Heavenly Glory—shining from the presence of God
 - b. Supernatural Ability—more powerful than humans.

C. <u>A Caution Regarding Angels</u>

- **1. Angels must not be worshipped.** (Col 2:18; Rev 22:9)—revered because of Who they represent, Who they work for.
- **2.** Angels can be <u>impersonated</u> by demons. (2 Cor 11:14; Gal 1:8; 1 Jn 4:1). Fallen Angels work against God to mislead and destroy humanity.
- **3. Angels should not be our <u>obsession</u>**. (1 Cor 2:2; Col 2:18-19; Tit 1:10, 13) Don't lose the focus of our faith
- II. God's Son ()—He is the focus, not the angels. He is SUPERIOR to the Angels.
 - **A.** He holds <u>Messianic Title</u>. (1:5; 2 Sam 7:12-16; Ps 2:7-8; Ps 8)—David's son would build God's House, sit on David's throne forever and rule the nations.

- **B.** He is <u>Divine</u>. (1:6, 8-13)
 - 1. The Angels worship the Son.
 - **2. David refers to Him as God.** (Ps 45:6-7; Lk 20:41-44)
 - 3. He is worshipped as the Creator. (Ps 102:25)
 - 4. He is extolled as Eternal. (Ps 102:26-27)
- **C.** He is <u>Human</u> (2:5-9)
 - 1. He is David's Son. (2 Sam 7:12-16)—Jesus' genealogy
 - **2. He is a son of man.** (Ps 8:4-6)—a descendent of Adam; redeems and fulfills the kingship of Adam
- III. Lord of All (1:3-4; 1 Peter 3:22; Mat 28:18; 1 Cor 15:25)—Enthroned in Heaven
 - A. <u>Became</u> superior to angels (1:4a; Phil 2:5-11)—humbled to human, exalted as divine Messiah
 - **B.** The <u>name</u> he inherited (1:4b; Isa 45:23)—the Lord/LORD; OT prophecy regarding the <u>LORD</u> (YHWH) applied to Jesus
 - C. The <u>firstborn</u> (1:6; Rom 8:29; Col 1:18)—highest rank, heir of all things
