Matthew 6:7-15

Main Point:

According to Jesus' model, pray with a God-centered focus and with a confident faith in the loving care of your Heavenly Father.

1. Jesus teaches you how to pray in the Lord's Prayer.

2. Pray with a God-centered, rather than a man-centered, focus.

3. God-centered praying includes your personal needs as well.

4. Pray with a confident faith in your Heavenly Father.
