 - i. We see her *cure* (v.29)
 - ii. We see Jesus *concern* (v. 30)
 - iii. We witness her *confession* (vv.33,34)

III. A Dreaded Report (5:35-40a)

- 2) Jesus restricts those who came with Him (5:37)
- 3) Jesus encounters ridicule (5:38)
 - i.) The *confusion* (5:38)
 - ii.) The *contempt* (5:39–40a)

IV. The Resurrection (5:40b-43)

- 1) Jesus gives the little girl an order (5:40b-41)
- 2) Her immediate obedience (5:42)
- 3) Before Jesus departs he gives a tender word of caution (5:43)
