CHOSEN AND BLESSED

Ephesians 1:3-12

I. BLESSING GOD THE FATHER FOR BLESSING US

A. <u>The God and Father of Our Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps 2:7, 10 ; 2 Sam 7:14 ; Mat 3:17; Heb 1:5)—Jesus in His Messianic role—Christ, the "Son of God"

B. <u>Blessed in Christ</u> ()—our relationship with God the Father because we are united to Jesus Christ

C. <u>With Every Spiritual Blessing</u> (Jas 1:17)—spiritual (not worldly)

D. In the Heavenly Places ()—unseen spiritual realm in which we participate

II. <u>ELECTION & PREDESTINATION</u> (Rom 8:28-30; 9:8-24)—in eternity past God chose/selected those who will be saved

A. God's Choice

1. <u>Before the Foundation of the World</u> (Rom 9:11; Rev 13:8; Ps 139:13-18)

2. <u>His Will</u> (His Good Pleasure) (Ps 115:3; Jer 1:5; Jn 1:12-13; 6:37, 44; 15:16; Rom 10:13;)—emphasizes God's sovereign will/choice
—> <u>Foreknowledge</u>—to love that person ahead of time.

3. <u>In Love</u> (Deut 7:6-8; Isa 43:3-4; Jer 31:3; 1 Jn 4:19)

- B. God's Plan—not making it up as He goes
 - 1. Jesus was always the plan. (Rev 13:8)

2. Nothing can thwart God's plan for those He has chosen. (Ps 33:11; Dan 4:35; Act 13:48; Isa 14:24, 27; Prov 19:21; Jn 6:37-39; Rom 8:29-30)

- C. God's Grace grace is undeserved favor granted by superior to inferior
 - 1. <u>Unmerited</u>—We did not earn it
 - 2. <u>Rich</u>—not limited by emotional makeup or wealth and resources
 - 3. Lavished grace upon Us not sparing, grudging or the bare minimum

D. <u>God's Purpose</u>

1. That we should be holy and blameless before Him

a. justification (Gal 2:16; Col 1:22; Rom 9:11; Eph 5:25-27)—He chose us for adoption in order to give us the *relationship* in which He *sees* us as holy and blameless.

b. <u>sanctification</u> (Phil 1:6; Phil 2:12-13; Ps 138:8)—He chose us in order to *make us* holy, acceptable in His sight; He will see it through.

c. glorification (Rom 8:30; Jude 1:24)—the end goal and condition; We *will be* holy and blameless both in *status* and in *quality of character.*

2. To the <u>praise of His glorious grace</u> and for His glory— All the glory belongs to God; this is His character.

"The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever..." (Deut 29:29).
