## REVIEW

- Man is incapable of earning merit with God.
- God, therefore, brings man to Himself through promises; also known as covenants
- The first covenant was with Adam, and is called a covenant of works.

## REVIEW

- Adam's breaking of the first covenant rendered all humanity under the curse of the law.
- God made a second covenant, this of grace.
- This covenant requires faith; but God gives the faith.
