I can hear You say, "Come to me and rest."


There's no need to fear when the Shepherd's near.

#### David's Introduction to Saul 1 Samuel 16:14–23

King Saul suffered the consequences of his sin.

- King Saul was tormented Isaiah 57:19–21 I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith the LORD; and I will heal him. But the wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt. There is no peace, saith my God, to the wicked.
- King Saul sought relief through music.
- Therapeutic efforts alone can never cure a sin-sick heart 1 Samuel 18:10–11

David was providentially brought to King Saul.

- God's providence is His power to intervene in His creation to bring about His predetermined purpose.
- A servant of Saul providentially knew of David.
- David's character and skills were providentially nurtured.
- David was providentially accepted by King Saul 1 Samuel 15:28 So Samuel said to him, "The LORD has torn the kingdom of Israel from you today, and has given it to a neighbor of yours, who is better than you.

The Lord providentially put David in a place to bring conviction to Saul.

The Lord providentially put David in the king's court to prepare him to be king.

The Lord providentially prepared David to be the *psalmist of Israel - 2 Samuel 23:1–2*Now these are the last words of David. Thus says David the son of Jesse; Thus says the man raised up on high, The anointed of the God of Jacob, And the sweet psalmist of Israel: The Spirit of the LORD spoke by me, And His word was on my tongue.

- Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
