The Glory of Jesus Christ

Part Two Revelation 1:5-8

Introduction:

Read Revelation 1:1-5

Review the first three truths already taught from v.5:

- 1. Jesus is the Faithful Witness.
- 2. Jesus is the Firstborn from the Dead.
- 3. Jesus is the Ruler of Kings on the Earth.

Today we will study four more truths that reveal the glory of Jesus Christ through this passage.

Read Revelation 1:5-8

4. Jesus loves us.

 Consider together the incredible reality that an Almighty and holy God would love ungrateful and rebellious sinners.

Read John 15:9, 12-13

Contrast the love of the One True God versus the hateful, lying, destructive nature of Satan and his
demons. Contrast a relationship with Jesus Christ versus the appearement and fear relationship with
the gods of this world.

5. Jesus freed us from our sins by His blood.

Read John 1:23, 29-31, 35

Explain the ministry of John the Baptist and the imagery of the Savior being a Lamb.

Read 1 Peter 2:21-25

• Explain the substitutionary death of Jesus to pay for our sines and the giving of His life and righteousness to us in order to free us from our sins.

6. Jesus made us to be a kingdom.

• Once in the kingdom of Satan and outside of the kingdom of God, a slave of sin and death. Now, through the blood of Jesus, made into citizens of God's eternal kingdom!

Read 1 Peter 2:9-10

7. Jesus made us to be priests to God.

- We who once were enemies of God and had no relationship with Him are now intimate with God through Christ. Not only this, but we have the right of a priest, to speak to God in prayer and to pray on behalf of others!
- Contrast the monks and holy men of other faiths and animism with the NT role of the believer as a
 priest to God in Christ.

Read Revelation 1:5-8.
