

## God's Original Plan For Restoration

"...that whoever believes will in Him have eternal life." (Gen. 1-3, Jn. 1:12, 3:15, 3:16, 20:31)

1. When God created the world He said it was very good (Gen. 1:31).
  - a. Where did it all go wrong?
    - i. Satan lied, Adam and Eve believed it.
2. What was God going to do about it?
  - a. Put the soul of Satan and the soul of human race forever in opposition to one another.
  - b. Use the seed of woman in a plan for healing the world!
    - i. But first, what position did Adam's original sin put us in?
      1. "Through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to men, because all sinned."
        - a. The disease of sin was spread to the entire human race.
        - b. The consequence of sin involved death (physical and spiritual).
      - ii. Remember, God has a plan for this fallen and broken world, and that plan involves healing from the disease of sin, the affects of sin, and the consequences of sin.
        1. His plan involves His Son.
        2. His plan involves living forever with Him in Heaven.
        3. His plan to save sinners from hell costs us nothing, but it cost Jesus everything.
        4. His plan involved the death and resurrection of His Son.
        5. His plan requires faith alone in Jesus alone for the forgiveness of your sins.
          - a. What about Jesus must I believe in order to receive eternal life? The Gospel (Good News in 10 words)-"Christ died for my sins, and rose from the dead" (1 Cor. 15:1-4).
  - God's plan for you involves salvation from hell and a relationship that will last with Him forever in Heaven. In order to receive salvation, you must trust Jesus to save you of your sins through His sacrificial death, burial, and resurrection on your behalf. If you have not yet trusted Jesus as your Savior, would you do that today? \_\_\_\_\_
  - Believers, would you turn from your sin today before it hurts you or your family you and your family in ways you could have never imagined? \_\_\_\_\_
  - Believers, would you share the truth of the gospel with your children; and as a family, would you use your gifts, resources, time, etc. to share the gospel with others? \_\_\_\_\_
