## "AND AS FOR ME,..." Part 8: "The Message of God Saves" JONAH 3:1-10

- I. A SECOND CHANCE TO GET IT RIGHT
  - A. God speaks to Jonah a second time
    - 1. God is not finished with His message of <u>compassion</u> for those living in Nineveh
    - 2. God is not finished making a <u>leader</u> "...that great city..." God has just demonstrated His power over everything man could fear. The challenge of a big city may be considerable to a man alone but it is no different than a small challenge to the man with whom God resides!
    - 3. God is not finished with His <u>prophet</u> "We are immortal until our work on earth is done" -George Whitefield
    - 4. If you messed up and got swallowed by the fish of doubt and discouragement, repent
  - B. God gives the prophet specific instructions
    - 1. "Ărise..." There must be an actual <u>initiative</u> to get going. No pity party. It is an intentional action; a purposeful action; a starting step. It is getting out of the comfort zone. It initiates the momentum.
    - 2. "...go to..." Every journey begins with the first step. It is a <u>targeted</u> action—there is a destination. Once started, the rest is just putting one foot in front of the other, one step at a time.
