Daniel Chapter 1: Faithfulness Rewarded

The Basics of Chapter 1

- Begins with defeat (1).
- The Name of God is blasphemed (2).
- Some of the people of God are exiled, with particular boys targeted for the king's court (3-7).
 - Royal family and nobility (3)
 - Good looking (4)
 - Knowledgeable and able to learn quickly (4)
 - o Poise (4)
- These boys were told what to eat and drink (5).
- They underwent a probation period of 3 years (5).
- Among the many exiles were Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah.
- They were given Babylonian names.

• Nebuchadnezzar had the Hebrew boys' names changed. Why? He wanted the Hebrews to became Babylonians.

The King's Food

- The food was the best of the best "the king's food."
- Theories I've heard concerning why the boys refused to eat or drink "the king's food."
 - The food presented violated the Mosaic dietary laws (Leviticus 11).
 - The Hebrew boys were declaring their dependence on God & not the king.
- The reason they did not eat, however, is clear: they did not want to sanction idolatry.
 - At ancient feasts, participants would "offer" the meal to their god before consuming it.
 - Numbers 25:1-2
 - Judges 9:27
 - o Besides the rank idolatry, the real problem lay behind the false gods.
 - Leviticus 17:7
 - Deuteronomy 32:16-17
 - Psalm 106:37
- The reason the Daniel and his friends refused to eat "the king's meat" was so they would not be guilty of demon worship. See also 1 Corinthians 8 and 10.
- What's even more impressive: they were under a lot of pressure to comply (10)!

Faithfulness Vindicated

- Daniel and his friends were healthy at the end of the 10 day trial.
- This is evidence of God's faithfulness. There is no sensible reason that consuming vegetables and water alone should have led to significantly better health. God rewarded their faithfulness!
