## **Overcoming Obstacles by Faith** Matthew 17:14-27

## Main Point:

Overcome the obstacles in your life by trusting in the power and promises of your Savior.

1. Life is full of obstacles that test your faith in the Lord's power and promises.

2. Unlike you, when Jesus faced certain obstacles, He always overcame them.

3. Since Jesus overcame His obstacles, you are now able to overcome your obstacles in Him.

4. Trust your Savior and overcome the obstacles in your life!

**Matthew 10:1** <sup>1</sup> And when He had called His twelve disciples to *Him*, He gave them power *over* unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. (NKJV)
