Scott's hobbies include reading and learning, hiking, and travel.

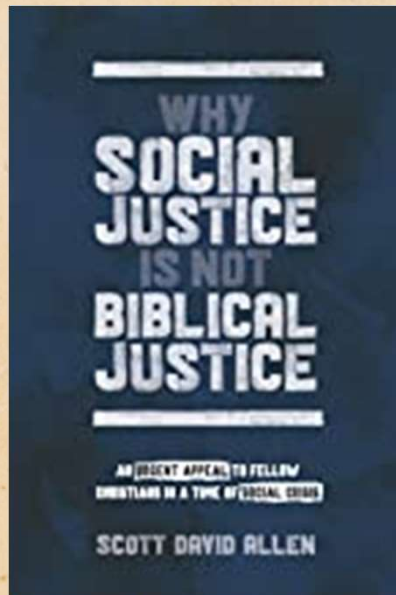
Scott is a part of Shiloh Community Church, an Evangelical Free denomination. He is presently on the elder board.

Scott served for more than 20 years with Food for the Hungry Int'l (www.fh.org). He is the cofounder and president of Disciple Nations Alliance since 2008.

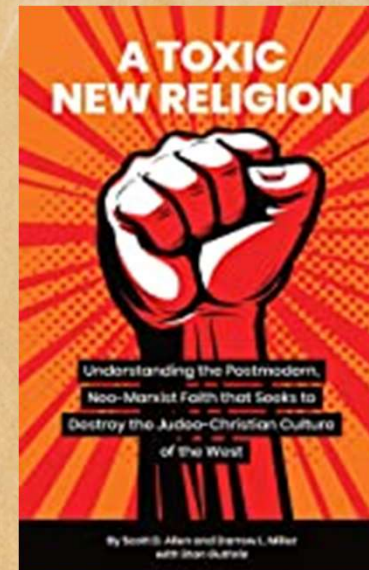

He also taught Introduction to New Testament Greek as adjunct faculty at Grove City College as well as Hebrew and Greek to various believers in the area.

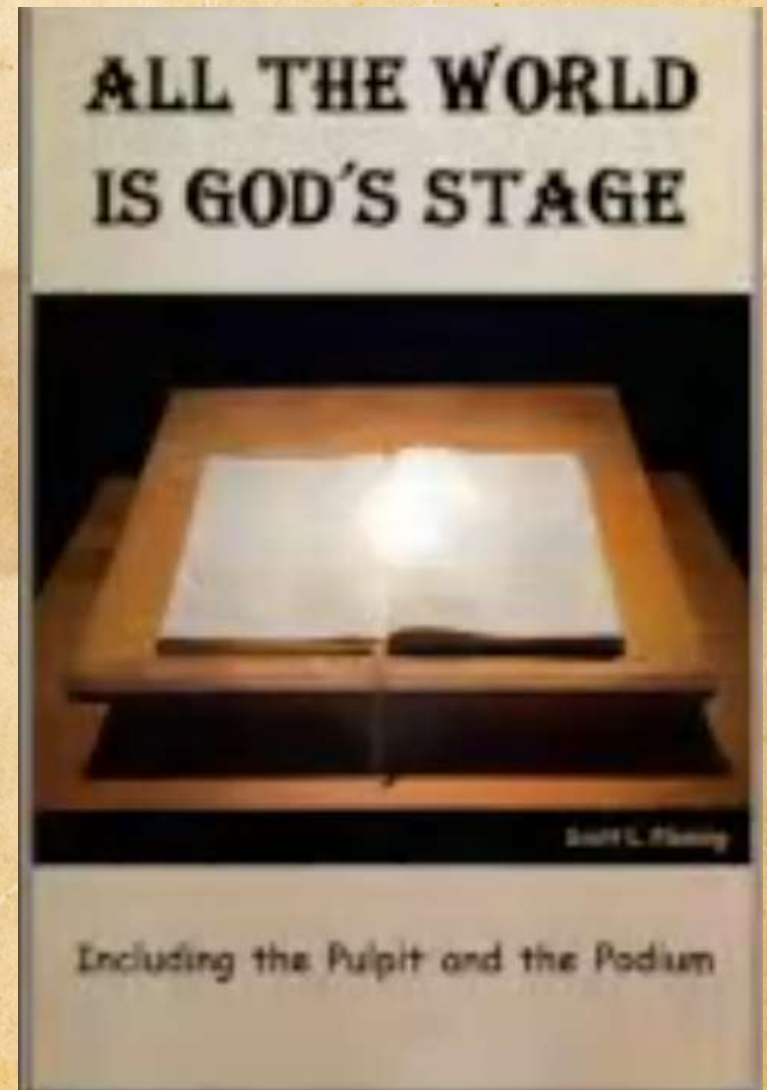
Pastor Scott is married to Nalene of 25 years, with whom he has five children: Nathanael, Anna, Emma, Matthew and Noah.

Jon Harris was scheduled to join us for this conference. Unfortunately, there was a death in the family preventing him from joining us.

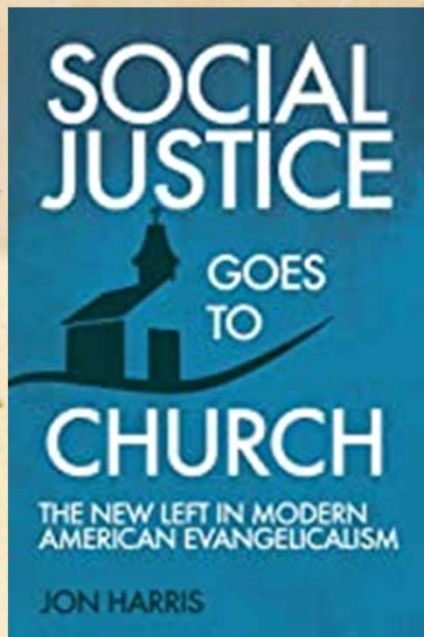
Jon has done careful historical research about the origins and development of CRT and its influence on the Evangelical church in America.
