I. The Generations (toledoth) of The Sons of Noah: Shem, Ham, Japheth v.1

II. The Sons of Japheth vv. 2-5

- A. Of Japheth: Gomer, Magog, Madai, Javan, Tubal, Meshech, and Tiras v.2 **Ezek 38:2**
 - 1. Of Gomer: Ashkenaz, Riphath, and Togarmah v.3
 - 2. Of Javan: Elishah, Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim v.4
- B. By These, Isles of Gentiles (Goyim) divided v.5
 - 1. In their lands (erets)
 - 2. Every one after his tongue
 - 3. After their families
 - 4. In their nations (goyim)

III. Sons of Ham vv. 6-20

- A. Of Ham: Cush, and Mizraim, and Phut, and Canaan v.6
 - 1. Of Cush: Seba, Havilah, Sabtah, Raamah, and Sabtecha v.7
 - a) Of Raamah: Sheba, and Dedan v.7
 - 2. *And* Cush begat Nimrod v.8 **Micah 5:6, 1 Chr 1:10**
 - a) Mighty One, Mighty Hunter, before the Lord vv. 8-9
 - b) Beginning of his kingdom: Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar v.10 **Rev 14:8**
 - c) went to Assyria and built Nineveh, Rehoboth Ir, Calah, ¹²and Resen between Nineveh and Calah vv.11 -12
 - 3. Of Mizraim: Ludim, Anamim, Lehabim, Naphtuhim, ¹⁴Pathrusim, and Casluhim (from whom came the Philistines and Caphtorim) vv.13-14
 - 4. Of Canaan: Sidon and Heth. v.15
 - a) Peoples of Canaan: ¹⁶the Jebusite, the Amorite, and the Girgashite; ¹⁷the Hivite, the Arkite, and the Sinite; ¹⁸the Arvadite, the Zemarite, and the Hamathite vv.16-18
 - b) Borders of Canaanites: Sidon, Gerar, as far as Gaza; then as you go toward Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboiim, as far as Lasha v.19
- B. Sons of Ham, in their families, languages, lands, nations v.20

IV. Sons of Shem, Father of Eber, Brother to Japheth the Elder vv. 21-31

- A. Sons of Shem: Elam, Asshur, Arphaxad, Lud, and Aram v.22
 - 1. Sons of Aram were Uz, Hul, Gether, and Mash v.23
 - 2. Arphaxad begot Salah, v.24
 - a) Salah begot Eber v.24
 - (1) To Eber were born two sons: Peleg (Divided?, River/Waters), for in his days the earth was divided (palag); and his brother's name was Joktan v.25 **Psa 1:3, 46:4, 65:9, 119:136**
 - (a) Joktan begot Almodad, Sheleph, Hazarmaveth, Jerah, ²⁷Hadoram, Uzal, Diklah, ²⁸Obal, Abimael, Sheba, ²⁹Ophir, Havilah, and Jobab vv. 26-29
 - (b) dwelling place was from Mesha as you go toward Sephar, the mountain of the east v.30
 - 3. These were the sons of Shem, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands, according to their nations v.31

V. Summary: Families of Sons of Noah; families, generations, nations

Genesis Chapter 10, The Table of Nations

Genesis 10:1–32 (NKJV) *Nations Descended from Noah*

10 Now this *is* the genealogy of the sons of Noah: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. And sons were born to them after the flood.

² The sons of Japheth were Gomer, Magog, Madai, Javan, Tubal, Meshech, and Tiras. ³ The sons of Gomer were Ashkenaz, Riphath, and Togarmah. ⁴ The sons of Javan were Elishah, Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim. ⁵ From these the coastland peoples of the Gentiles were separated into their lands, everyone according to his language, according to their families, into their nations.

⁶ The sons of Ham were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and Canaan. ⁷ The sons of Cush were Seba, Havilah, Sabtah, Raamah, and Sabtechah; and the sons of Raamah were Sheba and Dedan.

⁸ Cush begot Nimrod; he began to be a mighty one on the earth. ⁹ He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; therefore it is said, "Like Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD." ¹⁰ And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar. ¹¹ From that land he went to Assyria and built Nineveh, Rehoboth Ir, Calah, ¹² and Resen between Nineveh and Calah (that *is* the principal city).

¹³ Mizraim begot Ludim, Anamim, Lehabim, Naphtuhim, ¹⁴ Pathrusim, and Casluhim (from whom came the Philistines and Caphtorim).

¹⁵ Canaan begot Sidon his firstborn, and Heth; ¹⁶ the Jebusite, the Amorite, and the Girgashite; ¹⁷ the Hivite, the Arkite, and the Sinite; ¹⁸ the Arvadite, the Zemarite, and the Hamathite. Afterward the families of the Canaanites were dispersed. ¹⁹ And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon as you go toward Gerar, as far as Gaza; then as you go toward Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboiim, as far as Lasha. ²⁰ These were the sons of Ham, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands and in their nations.

²¹ And children were born also to Shem, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of Japheth the elder. ²² The sons of Shem were Elam, Asshur, Arphaxad, Lud, and Aram. ²³ The sons of Aram were Uz, Hul, Gether, and Mash. ²⁴ Arphaxad begot Salah, and Salah begot Eber. ²⁵ To Eber were born two sons: the name of one was Peleg, for in his days the earth was divided; and his brother's name was Joktan. ²⁶ Joktan begot Almodad, Sheleph, Hazarmaveth, Jerah, ²⁷ Hadoram, Uzal, Diklah, ²⁸ Obal, Abimael, Sheba, ²⁹ Ophir, Havilah, and Jobab. All these were the sons of Joktan. ³⁰ And their dwelling place was from Mesha as you go toward Sephar, the mountain of the east. ³¹ These were the sons of Shem, according to their families, according to their languages, in their lands, according to their nations.

³² These were the families of the sons of Noah, according to their generations, in their nations; and from these the nations were divided on the earth after the flood.

Ezekiel 38:1–3 (NKJV) *Gog and Allies Attack Israel*

Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ² "Son of man, set your face against Gog, of the land of Magog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal, and prophesy against him, ³ and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal.

⁶ They shall waste with the sword the land of Assyria,
And the land of Nimrod at its entrances;

¹⁰ Cush begot **Nimrod**; he began to be a mighty one on the earth.

Revelation 14:8 (NKJV)

⁸ And another angel followed, saying, "**Babylon** is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication."

Psalms 1:3 (NKJV)

³ He shall be like a tree
Planted by the **rivers** of water,
That brings forth its fruit in its season,
Whose leaf also shall not wither;
And whatever he does shall prosper.

Psalms 46:4 (NKJV)

⁴ *There is a **river** whose streams shall make glad the city of God,
The holy *place* of the tabernacle of the Most High.*

Psalms 119:136 (NKJV) – In the “Pe” section, first word, Peleg.

¹³⁶ **Rivers** of water run down from my eyes,
Because *men* do not keep Your law.

Genesis 9:24 (NKJV)

²⁴ So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his **younger** son had done to him.
