my God *in whom* I trust."

³ For he will deliver you from *the* snare of *the* fowler,
from *the* plague of destruction.

⁴ With his feathers he will cover you,
and under his wings you can take refuge.
His faithfulness *will be* a shield and a buckler.

⁵ You need not fear *the* terror of *the* night,
or the arrow *that* flies by day,

⁶ *or the* plague *that* spreads in the darkness,
or the destruction *that* devastates at noon.

⁷ A thousand may fall at your side,
and ten thousand at your right *hand*,
but it will not come near you.

⁸ You will only look with your eyes,
and see *the* punishment of *the* wicked.

⁹ **For you, O Yahweh, are my refuge.**

You have made the Most High your dwelling place.

¹⁰ No harm will befall you,
and no plague will come near your tent.

¹¹ For he will command his angels concerning you,
to watch over you in all your ways.

lest you strike your foot against a stone.
