- Messages of Comfort God will bring comfort and salvation through HIs suffering servant to all who will believe and repent. Christ is our righteousness and eternal joy (40-52 Comfort from God to Israel; 53-54 Comfort through Messiah the Servant; 55-66 Comfort from God to all the world).
