## "The Gift Of God" Romans 6:20-23

## **Introduction:**

- 1. In Matthew 6:24 Jesus Said:
  - "No Man Can Serve Two Masters!"
    - Not Only Is This True:
      - In The Natural World:
        - In Which We Live:
    - It Is Also True:
      - In The Spiritual World!
- 2. And This Is Why:
  - In Romans 6:
    - Which Is Where We Will Return:
      - In Our Bibles This Morning:
        - Romans 6!
  - This Is Why In Romans 6:
    - The Apostle Paul Describes:
      - Our Spiritual Relationships:
        - With Both Sin And With God:
          - In Terms Of Slavery & Even Voluntary Servitude!
    - But You Cannot Be:
      - A Servant Or A Slave:
        - Of Both At The Same Time!
          - You Are Either A Servant Of Sin *Or* You Are A Servant Of God And His Righteousness!
- 3. Well In Romans:
  - The Primary Audience For Paul:
    - Are Christians:
      - Who Have Been Justified By Faith:
        - In Jesus Christ!
  - And That Is Why He Called On Them:
    - And He Calls On Us:
      - At The End Of 6:19b To "Even so now yield your members servants/slaves to righteousness unto holiness!"
        - But This Is A Different Kind Of Slavery & A Different Kind Of Service Entirely!
    - Because When Jesus Called On Us:
      - To "Take My Yoke Upon You" In Matthew 11:
        - How Does He Describe His Yoke?
          - "For My Yoke Is Easy, And My Burden Is Light!"
- 4. Well In The Last 4 Verses Of Romans 6:
  - Paul Wants You To Remember:
    - What It *Was* Like:
      - When You Were Living Under The Yoke Of Sin:
        - And What It Now Is Like:
          - To Live Under The Yoke Of God!
  - And Just How Much Better:
    - God's Yoke Is!
      - 6:20-23 "For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. / What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death. / But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. / For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord!"
- 5. In Four These Verses:
  - Paul Compares The Only Two Kinds:
    - Of Spiritual Service There Can Be!
      - Because There Is Absolutely Noone In This World:
        - Who Is Independent:

- Of A Master!
- You Either Belong To:
  - Sin & The Devil Or:
    - You Belong To:
      - God & His Righteousness!
- And So Paul's First Focus Is On:
- 1. The Service Of Sin!
  - In 6:20-21:
    - "For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. / What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death!"
      - At The Beginning Of 6:20:
        - Paul Restates What He Says About Us:
          - Back In 6:17:
            - "Ye Were The Servants / Slaves Of Sin!"
      - Now One Of The Reasons:
        - Paul Uses The Illustration & Description Of Slavery:
          - For Our Past Spiritual Condition:
            - Is Because The Roman Church Would Have Understood Slavery!
      - And More Than Likely:
        - In That Church:
          - There Were Some Members:
            - Who Were Slaves!
        - But There Would Probably Have Been:
          - Other Members:
            - Who Actually *Owned* Slaves!
    - But With Slavery In Mind:
      - We Need To Remember:
        - What Our Past Service:
          - Was Like!
      - "Ye Were The Servants Of Sin!"
        - And It Was A Very Sad & Shameful Condition!
          - Because Paul Then Goes On To Describe:
  - The Freedom Of A Servant Of Sin!
    - Yes As A Servant Of Sin:
      - You Were Free:
        - But It Was A Sad Freedom Indeed:
          - Because 6:20 "Ye Were Free From Righteousness!"
    - I Think Paul Uses This Word:
      - "Free" Because:
        - This Is What Sinners Often Think & Feel About Themselves!
          - That By Sinning, They Are Free!
      - **IE:** But In Truth Sinners Are Like Animals Born & Bred In A Zoo! They Know Nothing But The Confines Of Their Cage Or Enclosure! And To Them That's Their Life & Freedom But In Reality They Are There To Serve As Objects Of Interest And Intrigue To The Public!
        - And That Is The Truth About Sin As Well! Sin Is Slavery!
    - And If There Is Any "Freedom" In Sin:
      - It Is A Freedom:
        - "From Righteousness!"
      - And As We See From Other Parts Of Scripture:
        - Those Who Are Servants Of Sin:
          - Are Ignorant Of True Righteousness!
            - They Are As We Once Were Deceived!
    - Because In A Sense:
      - Sin Even Becomes A Sinner's Righteousness!
        - Even As We Find Happening In Isaiah 5:20 When People Start To "Call Evil Good, And Good Evil" And "Put Darkness For Light And Light For Darkness" And "Put Bitter For Sweet And Sweet For Bitter!" They Are Even Become "Wise In Their Own

Eyes, And Prudent In Their Own Sight!"

- What A Sad Condition:
  - For A Sinner To Be In!
    - And You Need To Remember:
      - What Your Freedom Was Really Like:
        - When You Were A Servant Of Sin!
  - And Then:
    - 5:19 Keep Yielding Yourself:
      - To God As His Servant:
        - "To Righteousness Unto Holiness!"
- But Then Paul Describes:
- The Fruit Of A Servant Of Sin!
  - And He Asks Us A Question:
    - That We Are To Think About:
      - And Then Answer!
  - 5:21a "What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed?"
    - For The Word "Fruit" Other Translations Have:
      - "Benefit" But The Greek Word:
        - Is Karpos Fruit!
          - Because Sin Does Yield Fruit!
    - Remember What Paul Wrote:
      - In Galatians 6:7-8 "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. / For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting!"
  - There Is Fruit When You Sin:
    - Because Sin Is Like The Seed Of A Weed:
      - That Is Sown Into The Ground!
    - But What Kind Of "Fruit" Does Sin Produce?
      - Well Typically When You Plant A Fruit Tree You Want Fruit:
        - That Is Abundant & Fresh & Sweet & Nourishing!
      - But The Fruit Of Sin:
        - Is Always Rotten & Wilted & Sour & Poisonous!
    - Though Sin May Look Like:
      - The Fruit That Allured:
        - Eve & Adam In The Garden:
          - In That It Seemed "Good For Food" & "Pleasant To The Eyes!"
    - Yet Consider What The Fruit Was Really Like!
      - It May Have Been:
        - Sweet As Honey:
          - In Their Mouths!
      - But It Became:
        - Bitter:
- In Their Bellies & To Their / Our Souls!
- In Fact Didn't The Fruit Of Their Sin:
  - Lead To Their Shame?
    - What Was The First Thing They Did:
      - After They Ate Of That Forbidden Fruit?
  - Genesis 3:7-8 They Hid!
    - They First Hid Themselves From Themselves When They "Sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons!"
      - And They They "Hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden!"
- We Need To Remember:
  - That The "Pleasures Of Sin" Only Last:
    - For A "Season!" (Hebrews 11:25)
  - Because Then:
    - Your Sin Will Always:
      - Entice You Further!

- And Entrap You & Engulf You & Enslave You!
- This Is The True Fruit Of Sin!
- And Its Fruit Can Be Identified:
  - By How You Now Feel About It As A Christian!
    - 6:21 "Whereof Ye Are Now Ashamed?"
  - Have You Ever Wondered:
    - About Your Past:
      - How Could I Have Done That?
      - Why Did I Do That?
  - There Are Times In Our Lives Even As Christians:
    - When We Should Reflect On Our Past!
      - And Even Though You Are Free From The Guilt Of Your Sin:
        - You Are Not Entirely Free From Its Shame!
  - Because True Shame Over Sin:
    - Is Like That "Godly Sorrow" That "Worketh Repentance To Salvation Not To Be Repented Of!" (2 Corinthians 7:10)
      - Shame For A Christian Should Always Humble You & Bring You Back To The Cross At Which You Knelt And Received Christ!
- But What A Sad Condition:
  - For A Sinner To Be In!
    - And You Need To Reflect On:
      - The Kind Of Fruit Your Sin Produced:
        - When You Were A Servant Of Sin!
  - "What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed?"
    - The Fruit Of Shame:
      - And Pain & Sorrow:
        - And Even More!
    - The Fruit Of Sin:
      - Can Be Seen In Its Effects:
        - On Your Body, Your Mind, Your Spirit, Your Will, And Your Very Soul!
    - There Is No Good Fruit:
      - In Sin!
  - So Instead:
    - 5:19 Keep Yielding Yourself:
      - To God As His Servant:
        - "To Righteousness Unto Holiness!"
- Especially When You Realize:
- The Finish Of A Servant Of Sin!
  - At The End Of 5:21 "For The End Of Those Things Is Death!"
    - The Final Results:
      - Of Your Sin:
    - And The Finish Line:
      - For The Sinner:
    - Is Always Death!
      - Physical, Spiritual & Eternal Death:
        - Separation From God:
          - Forever!
  - James Puts It This Way:
    - In James 1:13-15 "Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: / But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. / Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death!"
  - So Even Though:
    - God Designed Death:
      - As A Punishment For Sin:
        - The Devil Uses It:

- To Keep His Slaves Entrapped Until:
  - They Are Finally Separated From Any Hope That God Offers!

- This Is What It's Like:
  - When You Are A Servant / Slave Of Sin!
    - This Is What It Was Like:
      - For You If You Are A Christian!
        - Because Paul Doesn't End Things Here!
  - He Does Want You To Remember & Reflect & Realize:
    - The Sad Condition:
      - Of Your Past!
        - But Now He Wants You To See Just How Much Better Things Are, Since You Are Now In:

## 2. The Service Of God!

- 6:22 "But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life!"
  - "But Now" Paul Writes!
    - Oh That These Words Were True:
      - For All Of You Today!
        - "But Now!"
    - May The Description:
      - Of Your Service To Sin:
        - Be In The Past! And:
    - May The Description:
      - Of Your Service To God:
        - Be In The Present!
    - "But Now!"
      - How Can This Happen?
        - By Admitting That You Were:
          - A Willing Servant To Sin!
        - By Realizing That:
          - There Is Now Good Fruit In Your Sin! It Only Yields Shame & Separation From God!
        - By Believing The Gospel:
          - That Jesus Lived / Died / Rose From The Dead For You!
        - Call Upon Him! "God Be Merciful To Me A Sinner!"
    - Romans 10:10 "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation!"
      - And Then This "But Now" Will Apply To You!
  - No Longer Are You:
    - Servants Of Sin!
      - Because Now:
        - You Have "Become Servants To God!"
          - And With God As Your New & True Master:
            - Just Look At:
- The Freedom Of A Servant Of God!
  - 6:22a "But Now Being Made Free *From Sin!*"
    - This Is True Freedom!
      - This Is Real Liberty!
        - Sin Is No Longer Your Master!
          - Its Grasp On You:
            - Is Gone!
  - **IE:** You've Been Released From The Zoo Of Sin And Have Been Given Freedom In The World Of God's Righteousness!
    - And Now You Can Live:
      - For God!
        - For His Glory! And:

- Remember This Morning:
  - The True Freedom You Now Have:
    - As A Servant Of God!
  - Because:
    - Along With Your Freedom:
      - You Will Discover:
- The Fruit Of The Servant Of God!
  - 6:22b "Ye Have Your Fruit Unto Holiness!"
    - As A Christian:
      - Your Fruit Will Be:
        - Good Fruit!
    - Not Rotten Like The Fruit Of Sin:
      - But Fresh!
    - Not Sour Like The Fruit Of Sin:
      - But Sweet!
    - Not Poisonous Like The Fruit Of Sin:
      - But Nourishing!
  - This Is The Kind Of Fruit:
    - Promised By God To Those:
      - Who Belong To Him!
    - Psalm 1:1-3 "Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. / But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. / And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper!"
      - This Is The Kind Of Fruit That Is Promised!
  - This Is The Kind Of Fruit:
    - That Is Produced By God:
      - In And Through His Servants!
    - Galatians 5:22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, / Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law!"
      - This Is The Kind Of Fruit That Is Produced!
  - This Is The Kind Of Fruit:

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- That Is Pleasing To God:
  - John 15:8 "Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples!"
- And Now That You Belong To God:
  - Not Only Will You Bear:
    - This Kind Of Fruit:
      - You Are This Kind Of Fruit:
        - To The Lord!
  - So That Now:
    - You Can Bear Your Fruit:
      - "Unto Holiness!"
    - **IE:** Like A Tree That Blossoms In The Spring To Be More Beautiful To The Eyes Of God To Be More Plentiful With Your Fruit And To Bring More Glory To The Branch That Bears You Up The Lord Jesus Who Is Your Vine!
- The Fruit Of The Servant Of God:
  - Will Yield A "Harvest Of Holiness":
    - That Reveals Just Who You Are!
  - Is This What You Are Pursuing:
    - With All Your Heart & Life Today?
      - 6:19 "Even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness!"
        - Let This Fruit Be Your Quest!
- Especially When You Consider:
- The Finish Of The Servant Of God!

- 6:22c "And The End Everlasting Life!"
  - This Is The Finish Line:
    - For The Servant Of God!
  - Keep This End:
    - In View!
- Because This Is What It's Like:
  - When You Are A Servant To God!
    - And We Need To Remember:
      - The Glorious Condition:
        - Of Our Present Occupation:
          - As God's Slaves!

## Conclusion:

- 1. And Then We Come To:
  - Romans 6:23 Which Is Likely:
    - A Verse You Have Memorized!
      - And If You Have:
        - It Is For Good Reason!
  - Because With This Verse:
    - Paul Provides A Summary Statement:
      - Of All That He Has Said Before:
        - But Especially Tying Together the "End" Results Of:
          - Serving Sin & Serving God!
    - "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord!"
- 2. You Need To Realize:
  - That When You Are A Servant Of Sin:
    - There Is A Payment:
      - For Your Sin!
        - There Is A Wage!
        - There Is A Just Recompense!
  - And Even Though:
    - Your Sins May Take On Different Forms:
      - The Payment Is Always The Same:
        - It Is Death!
    - And This Should Be No Surprise!
      - This Is What Sin Has Always Promised To Pay!
        - In Genesis 2:7 God Said To Adam & Eve "But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die!"
    - So Death Is The End:
      - Of The Sinners So-Called:
        - Freedom & Fruit!
          - This Is Your Finish Line!

- 3. "But!" (6:23)
  - If You Are Now A Servant Of God's:
    - There Is A Present:
      - And A Gift:
        - That God Has Reserved For You!
  - "Eternal Life!"
    - This Gift:
      - Is A Gracious Gift:
        - Because It Is Completely Undeserved!
    - This Gift:
      - Is A Generous Gift:
        - Because It Is Completely Unearned!
    - And This Gift:
      - Is A Good Gift:
        - Because It Is Completely Provided:

- "Through Jesus Christ Our Lord!"
- Because Of:
  - The Mission Of Jesus:
    - To Rescue Us!
- Because He Is:
  - The Messiah The Chosen One:
    - To Redeem Us!
- Now You Have The Privilege:
  - To Claim & To Call Him:
    - Your Own Master Your Lord:
      - And Serve Him With All Of Your Heart!
- 4. And "Eternal Life" Awaits You:
  - In The End As Your End!
    - But Its Not Really An End, Is It?
      - It's A Beginning!
    - A Beginning To:
      - A Never-Ending Life:
        - In An Eternal Home!
          - 2 Corinthians 5:1 "We have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens!"
    - A Beginning To:
      - A Never-Ending Life:
        - With An Eternal Happiness!
          - Isaiah 35:10 "And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away!"
    - A Beginning To:
      - A Never-Ending Life:
        - With An Eternal Harmony!
          - 2 Thessalonians 2:16 Because "Our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace!"
      - And A Beginning To:
        - A Never-Ending Life:
          - With An Eternal Holiness!
            - Romans 6:22 "But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life!"
- 5. What A Gift! What A Present!
  - "The Sinner Who Has Fled To God In Christ For Refuge Receives the Most For The Least: Life Everlasting For Nothing!" (William Hendrickson)
    - And If It Belongs To You Today:
      - Won't You:
        - 6:19 "Even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness!"

- \* What Is The Fruit Of Your Service? Good Or Bad?
- \* What Do You Have To Look Forward To? Death Or Eternal Life?
- \* Are You Living For God Today?

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
