
Revelation 19:1-9

Rev18:24: we were talking about the destruction of the commercial system of the world in Babylon, in an empire that's against God, a commercial system built up without God developed around the antichrist, built during the tribulation period. The Christians who are up in heaven, that have been raptured, are happy of this destruction. They know this is God's judgment, and they are happy.

Hallelujah!

Rev19:1: Everybody is happy after the rapture and the destruction of the false church. 'Alleluia' is a Hebrew term composed of three words that literally means 'Praise You Lord'.

Vs2: God judged the false religion.

Vs3: The destruction of the political city of Babylon will be a reminder to all for ever and eternity.

Vs4: The 24 elders that surround the throne of God, and the creatures that represent God's creation are all happy that God finally passed judgment, even though millions of people have just died.

Vs5: An angel or seraphim's voice came from the area of God's throne and said if you have committed to Jesus Christ, you have just become His bond servant, and you will do what He wants you to do. Doesn't matter your social status, all must praise God.

Vs6: this is God's creation, and we don't have any right to do as we please. It's His earth, and we should seek His guidance on what to do every single day.

Vs7-9: Lamb is Jesus; he will have a wife dressed in fine white linen and righteous acts. After the rapture, there is going to be a wedding in heaven between Jesus and the church. The churches will line up and answer for their works. What did you do during your lifetime as a Christian? All who passed will meet as a group and be the wife of Christ.

1 Cor 3:10: If you're going to build a building, the first thing you must do is build a good foundation. Spiritually, Paul says your spiritual foundation should be Jesus Christ. From that point on, you start building on that foundation. The choice is yours of how you live your Christian life. In Vs12, Paul gives 3 precious items and 3 common items. These items represent your works that will be shown to everybody, every little thing brought to light. It shall be revealed by fire. This here is the baptism by fire. If you've got gold, silver, and precious stones, they will survive the fire. If you got wood, hay, and stubble, it will burn up and you won't have any rewards, but you won't lose your salvation, you just won't have any rewards. These acts that are rewarded are your righteousnesses, your righteous acts. The reward will be one or more of the 5 crowns, and you will wear them all through eternity as a record of your service as a Christian.

2 Cor 11:2: Paul is jealous of what the good Christians will get. When all is said and done, Paul wants to present his Christians as a clean as possible. Paul is worried that Satan is going to corrupt the message from how to get salvation through Christ.

Ephesians 5:25-32: Husbands love your wives, just like Christ loves the church. Husbands should love their wives just like they love their own body. Love our spouses like Christ loves the church.

John 3:22-29: The guests at the wedding of Christ and the Church will be the old-time saints: Moses, Abraham, John, Paul, etc. They won't be part of the bride group, the church.
