## **Titus 1:5–9 (NKJV)**

**5** For this reason I left you in Crete, that you should set in order the things that are lacking, and appoint elders in every city as I commanded you—

**6** if a man is blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of dissipation or insubordination.
