Our God is HOLY!

A. Revelation of God’s Holiness

1. The Pervasiveness of God’s holiness
2. The Definition of God’s holiness
3. The Implications of God’s Holiness
 - a. Because God is holy, He cannot sin or be tempted with sin.
 - b. Because God is holy, He sets the standards of right and wrong.

B. Responses to God’s Holiness

1. Some respond by PROFANING God’s Holiness
 - a. Illustrated in the Life of Uzziah-- 2 Chronicles 26 (pg. 520)
 - b. Profaning God’s holiness results in judgment by God
 - 1) Case of Nadab and Abihu-- Leviticus 10:1-3
 - 2) Case of Moses and Aaron-- Numbers 20
 - c. Ways in which we profane God’s holiness today
2. Some respond by RECOGNIZING their own sinfulness, REPENTING of their sin, and OFFERING their bodies to God as living sacrifices--as illustrated by Isaiah-- Isaiah 6:1-8
