Are You Thirsty? John 7:25-39

In John 7:25-39 we encounter one of the most dramatic and lifegiving invitations with a promise. Jesus promises rivers of living water to those who believe in Him. But what does it mean to, "thirst," and to "drink," and have "rivers of living water" flowing out of your heart. This scene takes place during the feast of Tabernacles, where the families are camping out in their booths remembering God's care for them in the wilderness. At the same time, hatred for Jesus is escalating and the plot to kill Jesus is solidifying. Even so, the Pharisees and the Temple police continue to allow Jesus to teach in the Temple. In this shocking story, Jesus offers living water to His enemies.
