# The First Vision Revelation 1:9-20

#### I. The Context and Commission (9-11)

- 1. John, your brother and partner...
  - a. In the tribulation (John 16:33; Acts 14:22)
  - b. And the kingdom (Acts 28:31
  - c. And the patient endurance (Hebrews 12:1-3)

....that **are** in Jesus...

2. Was on an island called Patmos...

Patmos was a six-by-ten-mile rocky island about 37 miles off the coast of Miletus in the Aegean Sea.

- a. **On account** of the Word of God and the Testimony of Jesus. (Rev. 1:2)
- 3. I was...
  - a. In the Spirit (Ezekiel 3:12)
  - b. On the Lord's Day (Acts 20:7)
- c. I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet Theophany (Exodus 19:17-20)
- 4. The Commission
  - a. Write what you SEE
  - b. Send it to the seven Churches a message to the universal church Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, Laodicea

#### II. A Glorious Vision (12-16)

- 1. I turned to **see the voice** which was speaking to me... (Exodus 20:18, LXX)
- 2. Seven Golden Lampstands Churches (1:20)
  - a. Tabernacle Exodus 25
  - b. Temple Zechariah 4:2-9
- 3. And in the midst of the lampstands...
  - a. one like **a son of man** (Dan. 7:9-13; 10:5-6)
    - 1. Clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash on his chest (Dan.10:5)
    - 2. Hairs of his head white like wool, as white as snow (Dan. 7:9)
    - 3. Eyes were like a flame of fire (Dan. 10:6)
    - 4. His feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace (Dan. 3:24-25)
    - 5. His voice was like the roar of many waters (Ezekiel 1:24; 43:2)
    - 6. His right hand held seven stars (Rev. 1:20)
    - 7. From his mouth came a two-edged sword (Isa. 11:4; 49:2; Heb. 4:12)
    - 8. His face was like he sun shining in full (Judg. 5:31; Ps. 84:11; Matt. 17:2)

### III. A Glorious Comfort (17-20)

- 1. John's Response to the Glorified Son of Man
  - a. I fell at his feet as thought dead...

(Ex. 33:18-23; Ezek. 1:28; Isaiah 6)

- 2. The Glorified Son of Man's Response to John
  - a. He placed his Right hand on me and said Fear Not...

(Dan. 10:10-12; Lk. 5:8-10)

b. I am the First and the Last

(Isa. 41:4, 10; 44:2, 6; 48:12-13)

- c. The Living One (Deut. 32:39-40)
- d. I died and behold I am living forevermore (Living—dead—living)

Romans 6:9, 'We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him."

- e. I have the keys of death and hades (1 Cor. 15:54-55; Matt. 16:18)
- 3. An Instruction and an Interpretation
  - a. Write therefore...(Isa. 8:1; Hab. 2:2)
    - i. The things that you have seen... (Past)
    - ii. Those that are... (Present)
    - iii. Those that are to take place after this. (Future)
- \*All three of these realities will be present in every vision, and refers to the fullness of the Messianic Age.
  - b. An interpretation of the mystery...

i. Seven stars = seven angels (angelós) (Dan. 10:13-14; Jude 8-9; 2 Kgs 6:16-17;1 Cor. 11:10?)
```

ii. Seven Lampstands = seven churches

- 3. The church is to serve as bright lights in the broken world carrying the light of Christ to all as his faithful witnesses.
