### *Pleasing the Eyes of Christ*

1 Peter 3:8-12

***The text begins literally with something like "Now the end – all"***

***Read Romans 12:9-21.***

1. Christians are supposed to be in unity. In unity of what?
2. When we show sympathy, brotherly love, and a tender heart (or compassion), what does that practically look like?
3. The "all" means everyone in the church. Is it harder to have the proper Christian temperament with some folks than with others?
4. The last adjective is "humble-minded." Is humility self-deprecation or a willingness to put others first?
5. How does humility play into a refusal to seek revenge?

***Peter once again says, "to this you were called." He also wrote this in 2:21. What does he mean by this?***

***Read Philippians 1:27-30.***

1. Choose from the following options and discuss:
  - a. We are called to suffer without retaliation.
  - b. We are called to bless our enemies.
  - c. We are called to remember our inherited blessing.
  - d. We are called to the marks of Christian living recorded throughout our text and the context of 1:13-3:22.
2. How does a sense of calling impact our behavior?

***Verses 10-12 quote the Greek translation of Psalm 34:12-16. Will adherents to this counsel experience immediate "good days?"***

***Read Matthew 5:10-12.***
