

## A Night To Remember Mark 14:22-25

**The BIG Idea** ... \_\_\_\_\_ !

**The Scene** ... What the Passover meal looks like ...

- The \_\_\_\_\_ symbolizes the sacrifice that was made to save them.
- The unleavened bread reminds them that God rescued them with such \_\_\_\_\_ that they did not have time to finish baking bread.
- The bowl of saltwater symbolizes the \_\_\_\_\_ that were shed during the 430 years of slavery in Egypt.
- The bowl of bitter herbs reminds them that God had rescued them from the years of \_\_\_\_\_ living.
- The four cups of wine correspond to the four promises God made back in Exodus 6:6-7:

Cup 1: "I will \_\_\_\_\_ you out of Egypt."

Cup 2: "I will \_\_\_\_\_ you from your enemies."

Cup 3: "I will \_\_\_\_\_ you with my outstretched arm."

Cup 4: "I will \_\_\_\_\_ you to be my people and will be your God."

### The Simplicity

- The Gospel is so simple that it can be symbolized with \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

**The Symbolism** ... Everything that pointed back to Egypt now points to Jesus—so that we will remember Jesus.

- The bread symbolizes the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus, torn for us.
- The third cup of wine symbolizes the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus, shed for us.
- The act of eating and drinking symbolizes our desperate \_\_\_\_\_ on Jesus (Psalm 73:26).

**The Significance** ... When we partake of Communion, we are ...

1. Remembering Jesus by \_\_\_\_\_ to what He has done in dying for us.
  2. Remembering Jesus by \_\_\_\_\_ to what He will do for us. Matthew 26:29, "I will not drink again of this fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new it with you in my Father's kingdom."
- That's the \_\_\_\_\_ cup of wine—the cup that corresponds to God's final promise in Exodus 6:7, "I will take you to be my people and I will be your God."

### Four Ways We Remember Jesus

1. Come to the table \_\_\_\_\_.
2. Eat and drink \_\_\_\_\_.
3. Take Communion \_\_\_\_\_.
4. Celebrate Jesus \_\_\_\_\_.
